The CMAG Members' Lounge is a shared social space open to all members during CMAG opening hours, and offers a relaxing environment for members and their invited guests, magazine and resource library, children's activities and complimentary tea and coffee facilities.

PERSONAL CONDUCT AND USE OF THE MEMBERS' LOUNGE

- Members can expect to be treated respectfully by CMAG staff, and in return are expected to treat CMAG staff, visitors and fellow CMAG members with respect.
- Please be prepared to show your current membership card while using the Members' Lounge if requested by CMAG staff.
- Members and children in their care must behave in a manner that does not impede the right of others' to quiet enjoyment of CMAG's facilities.
- Small meetings are permitted, where the majority of a group are CMAG members. Consistent with the statement above such meetings should not impede the rights of other members.
- Complimentary tea and coffee facilities are available for use by CMAG members. Supplies are re-stocked regularly. Please be mindful and respectful of other members when utilising these facilities and leave them in the same state as you would wish to find them. Please wash and rinse crockery and cutlery after use and place in the drying rack at the sink.
- Consistent with the CMAG Service Charter members are expected to comply with all reasonable staff requests.
- Any concerns regarding the Members' Lounge should be reported to staff at the CMAG Front Desk as soon as possible.
