Access	 Learning programs traverse uneven ground which limits safe use of wheelchairs in Homestead precinct at Lanyon. Mugga Mugga Cottage and Calthorpes House are not suitable for wheelchair access and have uneven ground and some steps. Lanyon Homestead has one wheelchair accessible toilet. 		
Emergencies	 Emergency procedures are in place at venues. Staff are trained annually in bushfire preparedness. 		
First Aid/ medical emergencies	 First aid kits are available at each venue. Visitor Service Officers are trained in First Aid. In the case of medical emergency dial 000. If mobile reception is not working radio the Homestead who will call via landline. Visitor Service Officers carry 2-way radios at all times during learning programs.
